Official Information Act Request for – ICU Capacity and Isolation Rooms – partial transfer Ref: H202006152

I write in response to your Official Information Act request received by us 10th September 2020 by way of partial transfer from the Ministry of Health (Ref: H202006152), you requested the following information:

Please can I have the updated information – as of this month, how many ICU beds, HDU/CCU beds, and negative isolation pressure rooms across all DHBs?

Counties Manukau Health Response:

Table 1 below indicates the number of beds Counties Manukau Health (CM Health) has in our Intensive Care Unit, High Dependency Unit and Coronary Care Unit.

CM Health has a total of 60 negative pressure isolation rooms across the organisation.

Intensive Care Unit	12 (6 additional bed spaces could be utilised if staffed)
High Dependency Unit	6 (1 additional bed space could be utilised if staffed)

For context Counties Manukau Health (CM Health) employs over 7,500 staff and provides health and support services to people living in the Counties Manukau region (approx. 569,400 people). We see over 118,000 people in our Emergency Department each year, and over 2,000 visitors come through Middlemore Hospital daily.

Our services are delivered via hospital, outpatient, ambulatory and community-based models of care. We provide regional and supra-regional specialist services i.e. for orthopaedics, plastics, burns and spinal services. There are also several specialist services provided including tertiary surgical services, medical services, mental health and addiction services.
