Official Information Act Request for – Ambulance Admissions

I write in response to your Official Information Act request received by us 15th March 2022, you requested the following information:

 For the time period of 1st November 2013 up to now, the number of admissions to ED via ambulance, and the date of these admissions, where the ambulance has come from: Asylum Paintball, 833 Kingseat Rd, Kingseat 2580

Counties Manukau Health Response:

In response to your request, we do not hold information of the pick-up location of a patient when they transported via Ambulance, we only hold information about whether someone is transported via ambulance. Information relating to this may be held by St John Ambulance however we are unable to supply this information.

We have, therefore, determined to decline your request under Section 18(g) of the Official Information Act 1982 as the information requested is not held by the department.
