Official Information Act Request for – Dieticians Merit Applications

I write in response to your Official Information Act request received by us 18th March 2022, you requested the following information:

- 1. The number of merit applications broken down into Dietitians, Dietitian Assistants, and Dietitian Interns at your DHB.
- 2. The number of successful merit applications broken down into Dietitians, Dietitian Assistants, and Dietitian Interns at your DHB.

We followed up with you on the 23rd March 2022 requesting the date range for your request. You responded the same day requesting information "... Can we please ask for the information to fall under the last 12 months? 18th March 2021 to be exact."

Counties Manukau Health Response:

For context Counties Manukau Health (CM Health) employs over 8,500 staff and provides health and support services to people living in the Counties Manukau region (approx. 601,490 people). We see over 118,000 people in our Emergency Department each year, and over 2,000 visitors come through Middlemore Hospital daily.

Our services are delivered via hospital, outpatient, ambulatory and community-based models of care. We provide regional and supra-regional specialist services i.e. for orthopaedics, plastics, burns and spinal services. There are also several specialist services provided including tertiary surgical services, medical services, mental health and addiction services.

1. The number of merit applications broken down into Dietitians, Dietitian Assistants, and Dietitian Interns at your DHB.

The number of Dietician merit applications for the last twelve months (18/03/2021-18/03/2022) is four with two pending.

2. The number of successful merit applications broken down into Dietitians, Dietitian Assistants, and Dietitian Interns at your DHB.

We have assumed this means those who have passed CASP during the time period outlined in question one and is in addition to the above total.
